






Rooms at Vayu Retreat are aesthetically designed

RIVERSIDE WALK




Taking a walk towards the riverside at the end of the valley is highly recommended. More than anything, meandering your way through the paddy fields, apricot blossoms, and seeing the happy faces of villagers make you appreciate mountain life like anything. The scenic beauty of these remote places is unmatched.



You should ideally start the walk early morning to avoid harsh light. The sound of water was therapeutic to the ears. I loved the peach blossom farm on the other side of the river where we had fresh lime water, especially prepared by the staff of Vayu Retreat.

MEETING THE LOCALS

If anything excites me the most, it is to meet locals on my travels. I find it quite fascinating when I get to meet the local people of that area and indulge in meaningful conversations. On our way back from the riverside, we were stopped by Mrs. Pusha Ji for a cup of tea. It just melts my heart the way they open their door and heart to a stranger

HOW TO REACH VAYU RETREAT



Vayu Retreat is located around 350 km from Delhi. It takes approximately 8 hours by road. You can also opt for Kathgodam Shatabdi (from NDLS) express train, which reaches Kathgodam at 11:30 am. From Kathgodam station, it takes 2 hrs by car to reach the retreat.
